General findings:

Overall, the training was considered very useful. They stated that it was interesting, and very useful to increase their knowledge. The questionnaire was filled by 35 out of 43 trainees. As to the questions whereby the opinion of the trainees was assessed according to a 4 point scale: an average of 90% agrees or fully agree that they have now a better insight in the theme, felt they could speak out during the training, had the possibility to participate actively, while 85% stated that the used work forms were sufficiently adapted to the theme of the course and 90% agreed that the training was coached in an exciting and vibrant way.

The trainees highlighted NGOs role and opportunities, networking, and solid waste management as important topics they would like to pay more attention to in the future. As to the opinion of the trainees on the elements of the training they would like to be seen adapted/ included if the course was to be given again they would suggest more working groups/case studies, a major role of the field trip within the course, less technicalities, and better translation.
