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H2020 CB/MEP: 2010-2014

- CB activities: 104 (to date)  130 by the end of the project
- Trainees: 2600 (to date)  3300 by the end of the project
- Stakeholders reached: maintain the good distribution achieved so far
- Trainers, experts, lecturers: 350  over 400 by the end of the project
- Concrete impacts visible in institutional strengthening in countries

Capitalising on positive elements in shaping 2014-2020

Good results so far but reaching the critical mass of trained people to obtain the goals of Horizon 2020 requires more capacity building activities throughout the region, including West Balkans and Turkey

- ✓ *By ensuring synergies with processes and programmes*

Capitalising on positive elements in shaping 2014-2020

To avoid having any gap and to keep the vitality and enthusiasm of the countries and other stakeholders involved

Provisions should be in place by the EC through mechanisms (funding and process) to ensure continuity of H2020 CB/MEP at the end of 2014

Capitalising on positive elements in shaping 2014-2020

thoughtful design should include:

- Maintaining focus
- Participatory approach and thorough consultation
- Transparency
- Discussion and confirmation of priorities and needs by the countries individually, at CB Sub Group Meetings and at the Steering Group Meetings
- Securing synergies with other H2020 components and ongoing relevant processes, projects and programmes
- Securing more input from relevant EU funded research programmes

Capitalising on positive elements in shaping 2014-2020

A robust implementation with local involvement requires:

- Relevance
- Quality
- Ownership
- Cost effectiveness
- Timeliness
- Trainees selection process
- Fine-tuning
- Visibility

Capitalising on positive elements in shaping 2014-2020

- Enhanced coordination at national level
- Country reports/bulletins on H2020 achievements
- Trainings on legislation to support national frameworks and on enforcement mechanisms
- More activities in the field with local case studies and eventually pilot programmes
- Specific training cycles with knowledge deepening for selected trainees
- Training of Trainers methodology
- Differentiated trainings for specific target groups, for example decision makers
- Differentiated trainings for specific economic/industrial sectors
- Differentiated on specific local issues/areas
- Study visits with longer duration
- Short exchanges/internships among administrations, etc.
- Higher percentage of nominees from other sources
- Fine-tuning of selection process
- Enhanced participation of civil society
- Enhanced education and awareness
- Facilitated e-learning with examination through ‘theses’
- Further input/synergy from relevant science and technology programmes
- Enhanced post-training monitoring and follow-up
- Enhanced evaluation of direct impacts
